Program Description

IDOT's electronic submittal of crash reports from Illinois law enforcement agencies is currently at 96%, with 4% being paper crash reports. Through this grant, IDOT proposes to increase the electronic crash report submittals by approximately 10,500. This will be accomplished by providing laptops to agencies that currently submit 20 or more crash reports via paper.

Funding Source Description

On November 15, 2021, Congress enacted the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA) P.L. 117-58, also referred to as the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law (BIL). Pursuant to BIL, section 24108(d), Congress mandated that the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA) establish the State Electronic Data Collection (SEDC) program to provide grants to States to upgrade and standardize state crash data systems to enable full electronic data transfer to NHTSA, which includes enabling electronic data collection, intrastate data sharing, and electronic data transfer to NHTSA to increase the accuracy, timeliness, and accessibility of the data, including data relating to fatalities involving vulnerable road users. This program implements the BIL SEDC grant program.

Funding Restrictions

For the purchase of new laptops only, for those law enforcement agencies that are seeking to submit crash reports electronically. Only agencies not submitting crash reports electronically to IDOT are eligible to apply for this grant. The agencies will purchase the laptops and submit invoices to IDOT for payment. Expenses associated with installation and programming will be incurred by the law enforcement agency. The agencies will choose a vendor from the IDOT approved XML vendor list that will supply and install the necessary crash report application. The agency will have one year from the date of purchase to complete the installations and begin submitting crash reports electronically to IDOT. IDOT's Law Enforcement Liaisons (LELs) will visit each participating agency to ensure compliance.

This Notice of Funding Opportunity is to encourage law enforcement agencies to submit applications to purchase crash-resistant and weather-resistant laptop computers to install in their existing patrol units. Only agencies not submitting crash reports electronically to the Department are eligible to apply for this grant. Agencies currently in a contract with a third party vendor and submitting crash reports electronically to the Department will not be eligible to apply for this grant.

Review & Selection Process

All grant applications are assigned to the Bureau of Data Collection (BDC) staff for reviewing and scoring. Then, a second review will be completed by one of IDOT's program staff. The final score will be calculated by averaging the first two reviewer's scores.

Within 60 days of the award, the eligible agencies must put together an approved implementation plan to help ensure the agency will meet all the goals of this grant. The awarded agencies will be required to participate in conference calls with and/or submit status reports to BDC staff once a month to discuss the agency's progress throughout the grant year
